


Luke 24:44-46

⁴⁴ And he said unto them, These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were **written**

in **the law of Moses,**

and *in* **the prophets,**

and *in* **the psalms,** concerning me.

⁴⁵ Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand **the scriptures,**

⁴⁶ And said unto them, Thus **it is written,** and thus it behoved Christ to suffer,

and to rise from the dead the third day:

The importance of the Bodily Resurrection

1 Corinthians 15:12-19

¹² Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead? ¹³ But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen: ¹⁴ And **if Christ be not risen**, then *is* our preaching vain, and **your faith is also vain**. ¹⁵ Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not. ¹⁶ For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised: ¹⁷ **And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain**; ye are yet in your sins. ¹⁸ Then they also which are **fallen asleep** in Christ are perished. ¹⁹ If **in this life only** we have hope in Christ, **we are** of all men **most miserable**.

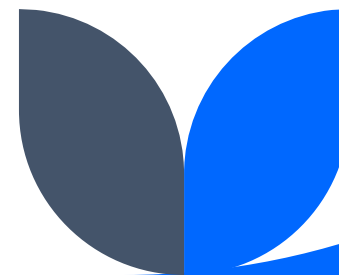

The Law of Moses - Abraham

Genesis 22:1-5 ¹ And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, *here I am*. ² And he said, **Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest**, and get thee into the land of Moriah; **and offer him there for a burnt offering** upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

³ And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him. ⁴ Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off. ⁵ And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and **I and the lad will** go yonder and worship, and **come again to you**.

Hebrews 11:17-19 ¹⁷ By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, ¹⁸ Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called: ¹⁹ **Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead;** from whence also he received him in a figure.



The Law of Moses - Joseph

Hebrews 11:22 **By faith** Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment **concerning his bones**.

Genesis 50:25 And Joseph took an oath of the children of Israel, saying, God will surely visit you, and ye **shall carry up my bones** from hence.

Exodus 13:19 And Moses took **the bones of Joseph** with him: for he had straitly sworn the children of Israel, saying, God will surely visit you; and ye **shall carry up my bones away** hence with you.

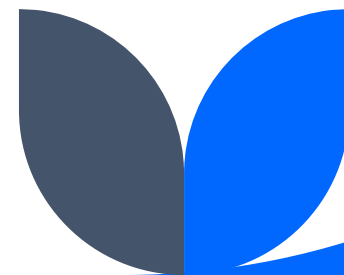
Joshua 24:32 And **the bones of Joseph**, which the children of Israel brought **up out of Egypt**, buried they in **Shechem**, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of **Shechem** for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.



Historical Books Give Historical Accounts

1Kings 17:17-22 ¹⁷ And it came to pass after these things, *that* the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick; and his sickness was so sore, that there was **no breath left in him**. ¹⁸ And she said unto **Elijah**, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son? ¹⁹ And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed. ²⁰ And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also brought evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaying her son? ²¹ And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, **let this child's soul come into him again***. ²² And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and **the soul of the child came into him again**, and he revived.

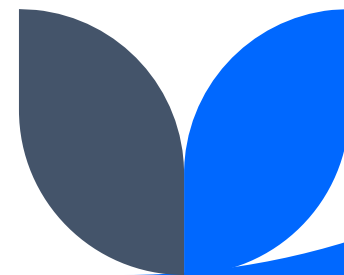
***Genesis 35:18** And it came to pass, **as her soul was in departing**, (for she died) that she called his name Ben-oni: but his father called him Benjamin.



Historical Books Give Historical Accounts

2Kings 4:18-20, 32-37 ¹⁸ And when the child was grown, it fell on a day, that he went out to his father to the reapers. ¹⁹ And he said unto his father, My head, my head. And he said to a lad, Carry him to his mother. ²⁰ And when he had taken him, and brought him to his mother, he sat on her knees till noon, **and then died.**

³² And when **Elisha** was come into the house, behold, **the child was dead**, and laid upon his bed. ³³ He went in therefore, and shut the door upon them twain, and prayed unto the LORD. ³⁴ And he went up, and lay upon the child, and put his mouth upon his mouth, and his eyes upon his eyes, and his hands upon his hands: and he stretched himself upon the child; and **the flesh of the child waxed warm.** ³⁵ Then he returned, and walked in the house to and fro; and went up, and stretched himself upon him: and **the child sneezed** seven times, and the child opened his eyes. ³⁶ And he called Gehazi, and said, Call this Shunammite. So he called her. And when she was come in unto him, he said, Take up thy son. ³⁷ Then she went in, and fell at his feet, and bowed herself to the ground, and took up her son, and went out.



The Psalms

Job 19:23-27 Oh that my words were now written! oh that they were printed in a book! That they were graven with an iron pen and lead in the rock for ever! For I know *that* my redeemer liveth, and *that* he shall stand at the latter *day* upon the earth: And *though* **after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God**: Whom I shall see for myself, and **mine eyes shall behold**, and not another; *though* my reins be consumed within me.

Psalm 16:8-11 I have set the LORD always before me: because *he is* at my right hand, I shall not be moved. Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: **my flesh also shall rest in hope**. For thou wilt not leave **my soul in hell**; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One **to see corruption**. Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence *is* fulness of joy; at thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

Psalm 71:20 *Thou*, which hast shewed me great and sore troubles, shalt **quicken** me again, and **shalt bring me up again from the depths of the earth**.



The Prophets-Major & Minor

Isaiah 26:19 Thy dead *men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise.*

Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew *is as the dew of herbs,*
and **the earth shall cast out the dead.**

Hosea 13:14 I will **ransom them from the power of the grave**; I will **redeem them from death**: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

Jonah 2:1-6 ¹ Then Jonah prayed unto the LORD his God out of the fish's belly, ² And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; **out of the belly of hell cried I, and** thou heardest my voice. ³ For thou hadst cast me into the deep, in the midst of the seas; and the floods compassed me about: all thy billows and thy waves passed over me. ⁴ Then I said, I am cast out of thy sight; yet I will look again toward thy holy temple. ⁵ The waters compassed me about, **even to the soul**: the depth closed me round about, the weeds were wrapped about my head. ⁶ I went down **to the bottoms** of the mountains; the earth with her bars *was about me for ever*: yet hast thou **brought up my life from corruption**, O LORD my God.



Prophets-Daniel

Daniel 12:1-2 And at that time shall **Michael** stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. **And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.**

Note the distinction

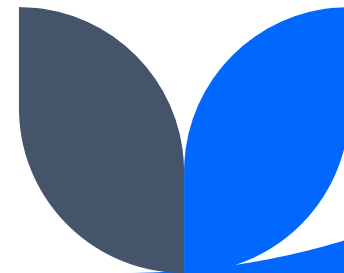
Revelation 12:7 And there was war in heaven:

Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

Jude 9 Yet **Michael the archangel**, when contending with the devil he disputed about **the body of Moses**, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, **with the voice of the archangel**, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Daniel 10:13 But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, **Michael, one of the chief princes**, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.



Jesus

John 5:28-29 ²⁸Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, ²⁹And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto **the resurrection of life**; and they that have done evil, unto **the resurrection of damnation**.

Note the distinction

Luke 14:14 And thou shalt be blessed; for they cannot recompense thee: for thou shalt be recompensed at the **resurrection of the just**.

Acts 24:14-15 ¹⁴ But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:

¹⁵And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be **a resurrection of the dead**, both of the **just** and **unjust**.



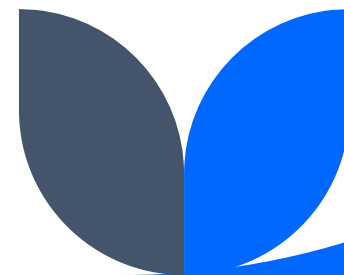
There are Believers

John 11:21-27 ²¹Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died. ²²But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give *it* thee. ²³Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

²⁴Martha saith unto him,

I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

²⁵Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: ²⁶And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. **Believest thou this?** ²⁷She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.



There are ALWAYS Nay Sayers

Acts 23:6-8 ⁶ But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men *and* brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of **the hope and resurrection of the dead** I am called in question. ⁷ And when he had so said, there arose a dissension between the Pharisees and the Sadducees: and the multitude was divided.

⁸ **For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection,** neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.

2 Tim 2:17-18 And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is **Hymenaeus** and Philetus; Who concerning the truth have **erred**, saying that **the resurrection is past already**; and overthrow the faith of some.

1 Tim 1:20 Of whom is **Hymenaeus** and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto Satan, that they may learn **not to blaspheme**.



How Many Resurrections in The Bible?

Revelation 20:1-6

¹ And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. ² And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him **a thousand years**, ³ And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the **thousand years** should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season...



How Many Resurrections in The Bible?

Revelation 20:4-6

⁴ And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and **judgment was given unto them:**

and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands;

and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

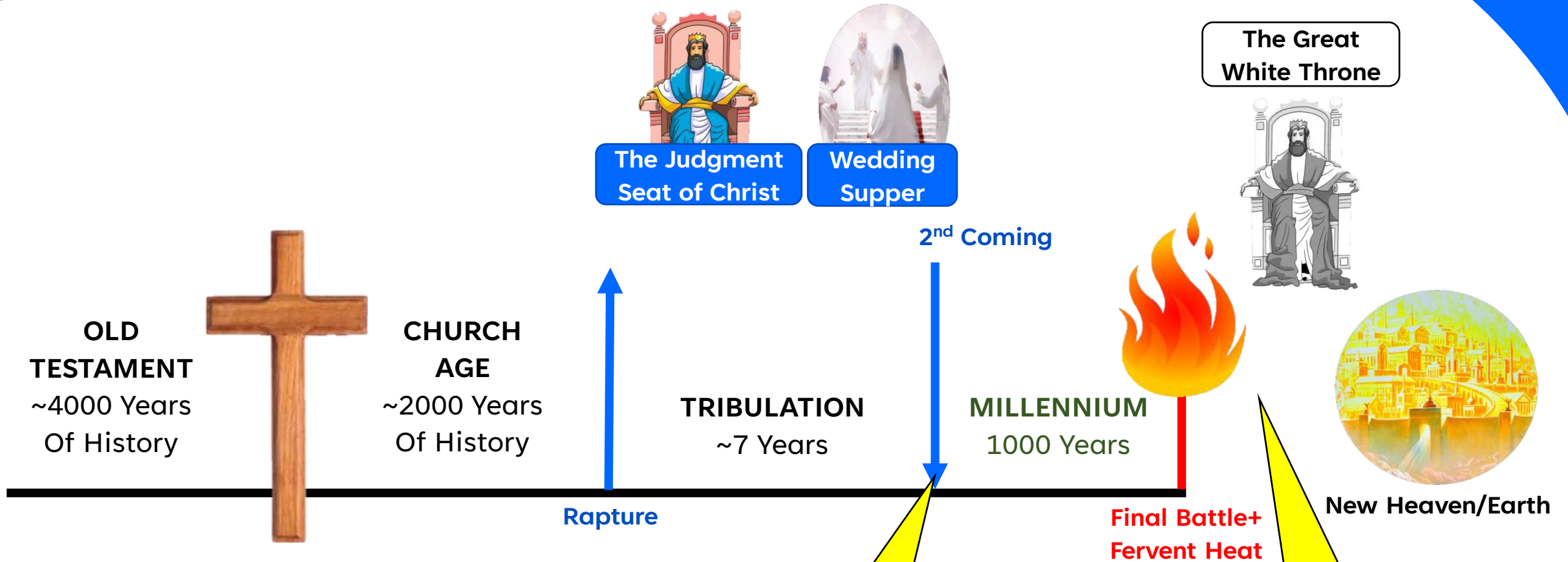
⁵ **But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished.**

This *is* the first resurrection.

⁶ Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in **the first resurrection**: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Where one is Judged varies**

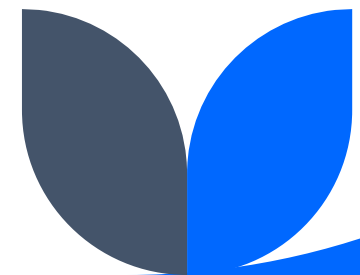
**The 1st Resurrection
