

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Ch 9

Matt <u>10</u>:5-6 ...Go not into the way of the Gentiles...

...But **go** rather **to the lost sheep of the house of Israel**.

Matt <u>11</u>:14-15

And if ye will receive it, this is Elias, which was for to come. He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Matt <u>12</u>:18-21

18 ...and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles...

21 And in his name **shall the Gentiles** trust.

Matt 13:9-11

Who hath ears to hear, let him hear...
...Why speakest thou unto them
in parables?

He answered...Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven...

Matthew 11:7-10 A Little Bit of Context

⁷ And as they departed, Jesus began to say unto the multitudes concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken with the wind? ⁸ But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? behold, they that wear soft *clothing* are in kings' houses. ⁹ But what went ye out for to see? A prophet? yea, I say unto you, and more than a prophet. ¹⁰ For this is *he*, of whom it is written, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.

Matthew 11:11-15 John the Baptist was a Key Player!

¹¹Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. ¹² And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force. ¹³ For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. ¹⁴ And if ye will receive it, this is Elias, which was for to come. ¹⁵ He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Something Particular is Preached in Matthew By two particular people

¹ In those days **came John the Baptist**, **preaching** in the wilderness of Judaea,


Matt 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. First Mention of "kingdom of heaven!"

Matt 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matt 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

The Bible is Clearly a Jewish Book About A Jewish King

A King Has a Kingdom The Kingdom of Heaven is King Jesus' Literal, Physical Kingdom

Matthew 11

¹² And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

¹³ For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. ¹⁴ And if ye will receive *it*, this is Elias, which was for to come. ¹⁵ He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

This is the KINGDOM that was offered to the Jews in Matthew & Acts (& Foreknowingly Rejected by Them)
This is AKA The Millennial (1000 year) Kingdom

Do Not Confuse It with The Kingdom of God Which is Spiritual

Luke 17:20-21 And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation: Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

1 Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Might one possibly consider it a Foreknown

"Graff Kingdom"???

The Kingdom of God "Graft Kingdom"? During the Double Mysteries of Today?

To the Circumcision

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

To the Uncircumcision

Colossians 1:27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

For sure a parallel kingdom, probably NOT a graft kingdom As it was mentioned even before Matt 11 in Matt 6:33

An Easy Way to Remember the 2 Kingdoms

The Kingdom of **HEAVEN A Place**

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Vs.

The Kingdom of **GOD Spiritual**

John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

WHAT IF: Would it really be that Bad, if we said they were the same? YES: It would be "a little leaven" growing into <u>BIG HERESIES</u>!

BIG Eg: Have you ever heard of Replacement Theology?

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The 7 "Mystery Kingdom" Parables Predict Church Age History in Order!

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As Jesus told these in order, **CLEARLY** He knew **THE GRAFT** would happen!
