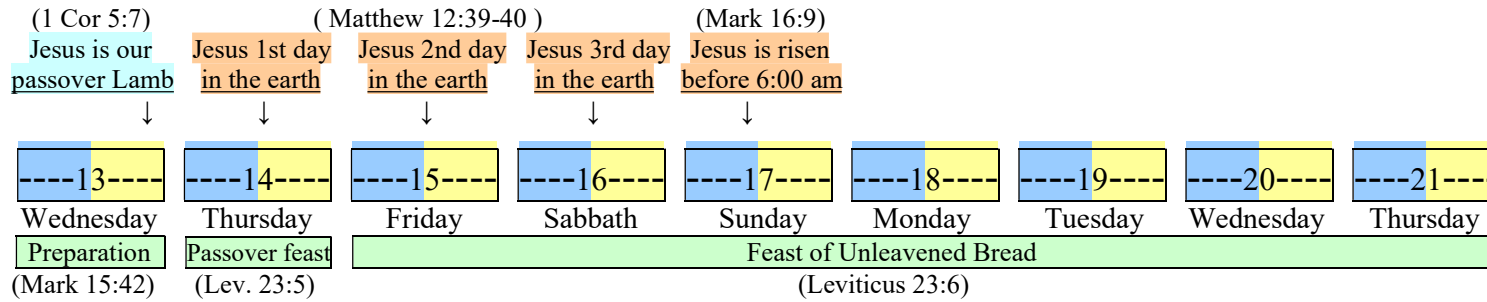
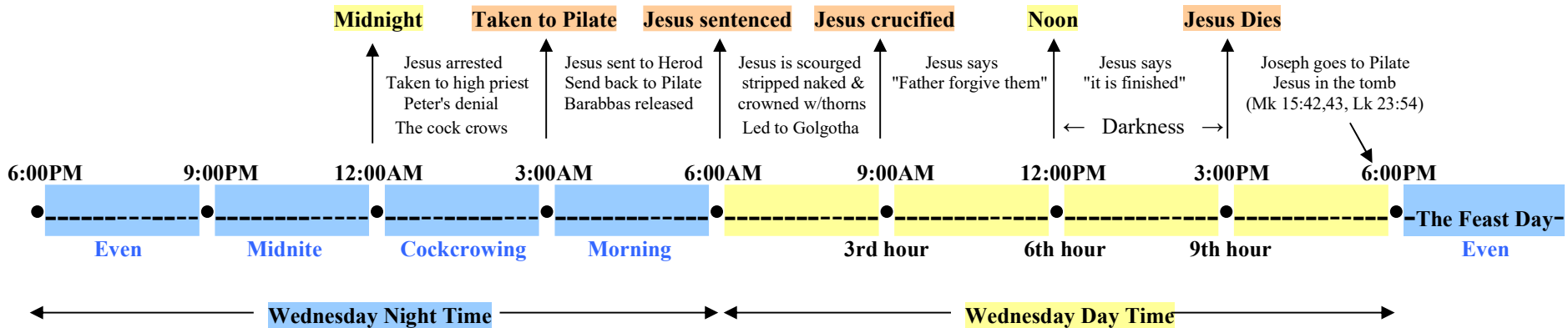


4th Passover Timeline handout

There are **4 passover feasts** during Christ's 3½ year earthly ministry. Jesus is crucified at the 4th passover: **1st: John 2:13, 23** **2nd: John 5:1** **3rd: John 6:4** **4th: John 11:55, 56**



Wednesday (The Preparation Day)



The order of events on Wednesday at the supper:

1. Jesus and the disciples eat the passover (John 13:1-4)
2. Jesus washes the disciples feet (John 13:4-17)
3. Jesus announces his betrayal (John 13:21-30)
4. Jesus offers the bread and the cup to the disciples (Mark 14:22)
5. Judas Iscariot goes out into the night (only in John 13:30)
6. Jesus begins his final discourse to the 11 disciples in the upper room after Judas has left (John 14:1-31)
7. They rise and start for the Mt. of Olives (Mark 14:26, John 14:31)
8. Jesus tells of Peter's denial (appears to be out of order with the other 3 accounts) (John 13:36-38)
9. Jesus continues his discourse to the eleven as they walk (John 15:1-16:33)
10. Jesus prays to the Father for the apostles and believers (John 17:1-26) (not the pray at Gethsemane)
11. Jesus and the eleven arrive at Gethsemane (John 18:1)
