

## Dr. J. Vernon McGee on The Pentateuch:

"The first five books of the Bible are called the Pentateuch. Pentateuch means "five books." These books were written by Moses and are identified in Scripture as the Law. Although the Mosaic authorship has been questioned, it is **affirmed by conservative scholars and confirmed by archaeology**. **Bible** believers unanimously accept the Mosaic authorship. (Deuteronomy 31:9, 24, 26; Acts 7:37-38)."

> It is interesting that the first appeal is to CONSERVATIVE SCHOLARSHIP, Next to ARCHEOLOGY, & Lastly to SCRIPTURE!

### WE DO NOT NEED TO DEPEND ON CONSERVATIVE SCHOLARSHIP NOR ARCHAEOLOGY. ALL WE NEED ARE THE SCRIPTURES!

#### 1. The Pentateuch Declares its Author <u>Deut 31:9</u>, <u>24</u>, <u>26</u>

9 And Moses wrote this law, and delivered it unto the priests the sons of Levi, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and unto all the elders of Israel.

24 And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished,

26 Take **this book** of the law, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, **that it may be there for a witness** against thee

### 2. Jesus Acknowledged Moses as the author of the Law

Luke 24:25-27 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

Luke 24:44–45 And he said unto them, These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and *in* the prophets, and *in* the psalms, concerning me. Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

3. W/o Doubt, Moses is the Implied Author in Matthew 19

### **The General Context**

### **Ch 19 Marks the END of Jesus' Galilean Ministry** (Remember The parallels to the Book of Revelation & the "Bookend Study")

Matthew 19:1-2 And it came to pass, *that* when Jesus had finished these sayings, he departed from Galilee, and came into the coasts of Judaea beyond Jordan; And great multitudes followed him; and he healed them there.

3 The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause?

#### 3. W/o Doubt, Moses is the Implied Author in Matthew 19 Let's Eavesdrop on this "Text Msg Thread!"

<sup>3</sup>...Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause?

Read: Today

<sup>4</sup> And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made *them* at the beginning made them male and female, <sup>5</sup> And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? <sup>6</sup> Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

> Read: Today Quoting Gen 1:27 & 2:23-24 & They <u>all</u> know Jesus is quoting Moses

<sup>7</sup> They say unto him, Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away?

**Replied: Today** 

With a contradiction written by Moses in Deut 24:1-3 Since Jesus is appealing to the writings of Moses

8 He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so.

Enough? Or Is there More?

<sup>9</sup> And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except *it be* for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery. Delivered

But not quite understood

Here, the true Author of the Law is adding an amendment

#### **GENESIS**

John 7:22-23 Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day circumcise a man. If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?

Vs. Genesis 17:11 And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you.

#### **EXODUS**

John 7:22-23 (above) vs. Exodus 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Mark 7:10 For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death: vs. Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother...

Mark 12:26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

**Vs. Exodus 3:6** Moreover he said, I *am* the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.



#### **LEVITICUS**

Matthew 8:4 And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

Luke 5:14 And he charged him to tell no man: but go, and shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing, according as Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

Leviticus 14:1-5 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought unto the priest: And the priest shall go forth out of the camp; and the priest shall look, and, behold, *if the plague of leprosy be healed in the leper*; Then shall the priest command to take for him that is to be cleansed two birds alive *and* clean, and cedar wood, and scarlet, and hyssop: And the priest shall command that one of the birds be killed in an earthen vessel over running water...

**19-20** And the priest shall **offer** the sin **offering**, and make an atonement for **him that is to be cleansed** from his uncleanness; and afterward he shall kill the burnt **offering**: And the priest shall offer the burnt **offering** and the meat **offering** upon the altar: and the priest shall **offering and the meat offering** upon the altar: and the priest shall **and the meat offering** upon the altar: and the priest shall **and the meat offering** upon the altar.

#### **NUMBERS**

John 3:14-16 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

**Vs. Numbers 21:8-9** And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that **every one** that is bitten, **when he looketh upon it, shall live**. And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

**2Kings 18:4** He removed the high places, and brake the images, and cut down the groves, and brake in pieces **the brasen serpent** that **Moses** had made: for unto those days the children of Israel did burn incense to it: and he called it **Nehushtan**.

"Why seek ye the living among the dead?"

#### DEUTERONOMY

Mark 10:3-9 And he answered and said unto them, What did Moses command you? And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement, and to put *her* away. And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the hardness of your heart he wrote you this precept...

**Vs. Deuteronomy 24:1** When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give *it* in her hand, and send her out of his house.


