At the Onset, the Israeli Encampment Around the Tabernacle has the rough proportions of a cross as if it were lying down from East to West **Ps 103:12**


With the Tabernacle at the Center Ex 25:8

New Testament

Jn 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Old Testament

Exo 24:7-8 And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient. And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled *it* on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

Hebrews 9:23-28

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v.23 Earthly things are after heavenly patterns

v.24-26 Jesus Christ is the **REAL DEAL** “One Man Show”

Heb 9:27-28 Ch. Concludes w/ a “Relatable” Analogy

“And as it is appointed unto men **once** to die,
but after this the judgment:

So **Christ was once offered** to bear the sins of many;
and unto them that look for him

shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.”
