## Long term Bible Question: ANSWERED! Why did King Solomon Have SO Many Gals?










- Thy neck is as a tower of ivory

## The Graft Was Predicted in The OT & Validated By Jesus Himself!

Isaiah 61:1-2 <sup>1</sup>The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound; <sup>2</sup>To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn:

Strike-Through is 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming, NOT 1<sup>st</sup> Coming!

Believe it or not, this single **COMMA** in the OT prophecy of Isaiah represents the grafted in Gentile Church Age!

Luke 4:14-20 ...<sup>18</sup>The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him.

#### Matthew 5:18

For verily I say unto you,
Till heaven and earth pass,
one jot or one tittle
shall in no wise pass from the law,
till all be fulfilled.

## SIDE NOTE: Scripture With Scripture ALWAYS Yields Insights & Definitions!

Isaiah 61:1-2 <sup>1</sup>The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek;

he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives,

and the opening of the **prison** to them that are bound;

<sup>2</sup>To **proclaim** the acceptable year of the LORD

and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn:

Luke 4:14-20 ...<sup>18</sup>The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the **gospel** to the poor;

he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives,

and recovering of sight to the **blind**, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

Rom 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

Note, "Coincidentally," this is the same chapter that talks about the Gentile grafting!

#### While Are Still On This Topic...

#### Sometimes The Bible Defines Words Straight-Forwardly

1 Samuel 9:9 (Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to inquire of God, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the seer: for *he that is now called a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer*.)

Like Jesus Quoting Isaiah 61:1-2, or what about this case?

## While Are Still On This Topic... Do Not Underestimate the Law of First Mention! "Cogitations?"

#### 1. Look at First Mention & Surrounding Context

Dan 7:28 Hitherto is the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.

2. Read the passage from the Beginning of the Paragraph (many Bibles have markings) PILCROW Dan 7:15 I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of my body, and the visions of my head troubled me.

3. Don't Forget About Comparing Scripture With Scripture! 1Cor 2:13

**Eph 4:23** And be renewed in the **spirit of your mind**;

Gen 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying...

Gen 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
