Who is the Judge?

John 5:19-23

v.22 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

John 4:24

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Luke 24:39

Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

John 1:1:18

No man hath seen God at any time;

the only begotten **Son**, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

Jesus Christ is the Judge, representing the interests of the Father.



The Great White Throne - General Judgment The One that Many Know & Fear

Rev 20:11-15 When? Rev 20:1-10 After the 1000 Years

¹¹ And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it,

from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. Where? 2Pet 3:10

- And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. Who is the defendant?

 Heb 9:27
- And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. What is judged?
- ¹⁴ And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. What is the basis of judgment?



The Judgment Seat of Christ - A Specific Judgment Not to be confused with the General Judgment

1Cor 3:11-15 Who is the Defendant? Rom 14:5-13 2Cor 5:8-10

¹¹ For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.



Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; ¹³ Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. What is judged? ² 2Cor 5:10</sup>

14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. 15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire. What is the basis of judgment?

Does this criteria match the other judgment?

Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life

was cast into the lake of fire. When? Where? 1Thes 4:16-18

Who? Where? When? The Blessed Hope (Rapture) The Judgment Seat of Christ Must be AFTER This Event

1Thes 4:16-18

¹⁶ For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout,

with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Group1: The dead in Christ

¹⁷ Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them


Group2: We which are alive

in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: Where? and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

¹⁸ Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

John 11:25-26 ... I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: (Group1) And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die... (Group2)
