TRAITS OF THE SIMPLE			
1	No Subtilty	Prov 1:4	To give <b>subtilty</b> to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion.
2	No Understanding	Prov 7:7	And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man <b>void of understanding</b> ,
3	No Knowledge	Prov 9:13	A foolish woman is clamorous: she is simple, and <b>knoweth nothing</b> .
4	Gullible	Prov 14:15	The simple <b>believeth every word</b> : but the prudent man looketh well to his going.
5	Influenceable	Prov 1:32	For the <b>turning away of the simple</b> shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.
6	Passive, No urgency	Prov 22:3 Prov 27:12	A prudent man foreseeth the evil, and hideth himself: but <b>the simple pass on</b> , and are punished. A prudent man foreseeth the evil, and hideth himself; but <b>the simple pass on</b> , and are punished.

THE SIMPLE ARE VULNERABLE TO:			
8	Foolishness	Prov 14:18	The simple <b>inherit folly</b> : but the prudent are crowned with knowledge.
9	Fear & Example	Prov 19:25	Smite a scorner, and <b>the simple will beware</b> : and reprove one that hath understanding, and he will understand knowledge.
10	Predators: Armed w/ <b>words</b>  <i>[definition: Basic, plain, bland, no spice]</i>	Rom 16:18  <i>Rom 16:19</i>	For <b>they</b> that are such <b>serve not our Lord Jesus Christ</b> , but their own belly; and <b>by good words and fair speeches deceive</b> the hearts of <b>the simple</b> .  <i>For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and <b>simple</b> concerning evil.</i>

13	Inviting & Welcoming	Prov 8:5 Prov 9:4 Prov 9:16	<b>O ye simple, understand wisdom</b> : and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart. <b>Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither</b> : as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him, <b>Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither</b> : and as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,
14	<b>The word of God</b>  Reinforced by Fear & neg example	Psa 19:7 Psa 119:130  Prov 21:11 Prov 1:7	<b>The law of the LORD is perfect</b> , converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, <b>making wise the simple</b> . The <b>entrance of thy words giveth light</b> ; <b>it giveth understanding unto the simple</b> .  <b>When the scorner is punished, the simple is made wise</b> : and when the wise is instructed, he receiveth knowledge. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
